Webb Dominates Mount Panorama Weekend:

It is regarded as the biggest weekend of the year in Australian Motorsport and Gulf Western Oil supported driver Jonathon Webb got amongst the celebrations by winning the sixth and penultimate round of the Fujitsu V8 Supercar Series at Bathurst's Mount Panorama in Central Western NSW.

For the # 26 Gulf Western Oil supported MW Motorsport prepared BF Ford Falcon driver this was his third round victory of the year in the Fujitsu Series and his second in succession after he won the previous round at QLD Raceway back in August.

In what was a mirror performance of his last round victory at QLD Raceway; Webb won both his races and dominated qualifying earlier in the weekend. These results have now moved him one step closer to clinching the Fujitsu Series title. Webb's Mount Panorama victory has now resulted in him extending his margin of his nearest rival to a total of 79 points.

"To win at Bathurst in a V8 Supercar is certainly a great achievement and it is very rewarding," expressed a very pleased Webb. "We worked hard early in the weekend to find a good setup during the practice sessions and by qualifying we were on the money and were able to build on that speed throughout both of the races."

To illustrate Webb's dominance around the 6.2km Mount Panorama circuit better he not only claimed the top spot in qualifying and in both races, he also lowered the lap record for the Fujitsu Series previously held by Dean Canto and won the second race by a mammoth 23 seconds. Webb's 23 second victory in the second race turned out to be a record as it was the biggest winning margin in V8 Supercar history.

"It was a mixed bag of weather throughout the weekend and it certainly kept the whole team on their toes. We stayed on the top of our game and we were rewarded with a magical weekend," Webb commented. "The MW Motorsport team and I have found a good balance in recent rounds and we just seem to be getting better with each race. That is a good thing to be doing when we are closing in on the Fujitsu Series title."

The seventh and final round of the Fujitsu Series is to be fought out on the weekend of December 4 – 6 for the inaugural Sydney Telstra 500 on the streets of Homebush in NSW.
