



## Webb Wins 2009 Fujitsu V8 Supercar Series Top Honours:

Gulf Western Oil supported driver Jonathon Webb was able to finish off the year in the best possible style by winning the seventh and final round of the Fujitsu V8 Supercar Series on the streets of Homebush, as part of the inaugural Sydney 500, over the weekend and sealing the overall honours.

Webb recorded his fourth round victory of the year in the Fujitsu Series and he did it by qualifying in second place, finishing second in the opening race and then the # 26 Gulf Western Oil / MW Motorsport backed BF Ford Falcon driver capped off the weekend by winning the second and final race.

"To win the Fujitsu Series is a wonderful achievement as I have been trying to do it for the past two years but have just fell sort and I guess it's a case of third time lucky," Webb expressed. "None of my success this year would have been possible without the support of the MW Motorsport team and my major sponsor Gulf Western Oil, as we have been getting stronger and stronger as the year progressed and it's great to reward the MW Motorsport team with their maiden Fujitsu Series title."

The Sydney 500 was a special event, not only because it was where he was able to win the Fujitsu Series, but also the fact that he was brought up around the Sydney area.

"Although I now reside up in Queensland, I still call Sydney home and it was a fabulous weekend as I was able to win the round and seal the Fujitsu Series in front of many of my family and friends," Webb commented. "Aside from wrapping up the Fujitsu Series the goal for the weekend was to win the round in front of all my family and friends and it was a great buzz to be able to do that."

Looking back over the seven rounds of the Fujitsu Series, Webb feels that the key to his success this year was momentum.

"The whole deal with the MW Motorsport team came together very late and it took a few rounds for us to find our rhythm," admitted Webb. "Once we found that rhythm we were able to build on that momentum and it rewarded us with the Fujitsu Series victory and four round wins in the process."

The plans for next year will see Webb make the step up into the 'Main Game' V8 Supercar Championship where he will drive the third car out of the Jim Beam / Dick Johnson Racing team stable.
